

Guideline regarding Continuing Education

At its December 9-10, 2003 meeting, the State Real Estate Commission adopted regulation 16A-561 regarding education in final form. At the same time, the Commission suspended enforcement of its continuing education regulations in accordance with the amendments. Specifically,

- Effective with this renewal period, licensees may complete their 14-hour continuing education requirement in 3½-hour increments instead of 7-hour increments.
- There is no required course for this renewal period. Licensees may complete their 14-hour requirement in any of the elective topics listed in Section 35.384(c).
- Real Estate education providers may electronically transfer continuing education rosters to the Commission in lieu of providing attendees with Certificates of Completion.
- Attendees who have completed courses in which rosters have been electronically transferred are not required to submit certificates of completion with their renewal applications and may renew online.

Licensees have been informed of these changes in the Fall 2003 State Real Estate Commission Newsletter, through announcements on the Commission's web page and on renewal materials. Additionally, real estate education providers have been informed of these changes through the above means as well as through a meeting with the State Real Estate Commission on December 9, 2003.
