



## iBox BT LE eKey Resource Guide

As most of you know, next week Montgomery County Association of Realtors® hosted its iBox Exchange Program on Monday, September 21 and Tuesday, September 22. **This event was not a key conversion, but an iBox Exchange only.** To make the transition as smooth as possible for our members, we have prepared a resource guide specifically for eKey users.

Please note that with the new iBox BT LE you do not need the fob to communicate with the phone. However, it is our strong recommendation that eKey users keep their fob in their possession as the transition may take a few weeks to complete. **How to Power Up the Box...It's a Little Different** - unlike the old iBoxes that were always on (and ran out of battery) these boxes need you to turn them on before they work with the eKey. To do that, press the key container (where the house keys are located) and look to make sure there is a blinking red light in the infrared lens to turn on the bluetooth. You need to turn the box on in order to release the key container and to release the shackle when using your eKey.

### Release a Shackle on the iBox BT LE with an eKey:

**How to Open the Shackle...It's a Little Different Too** - to release a shackle, the iBox BT LE needs to be turned on as well. Additionally, please be careful as the shackle is separate from the box now. The iBox BT LE does not just open on one side, it opens on both. Would will push down on the shackle and then pull the shackle out of the iBox - being careful to hold the iBox so it doesn't drop on your foot or the threshold of the seller's door.
